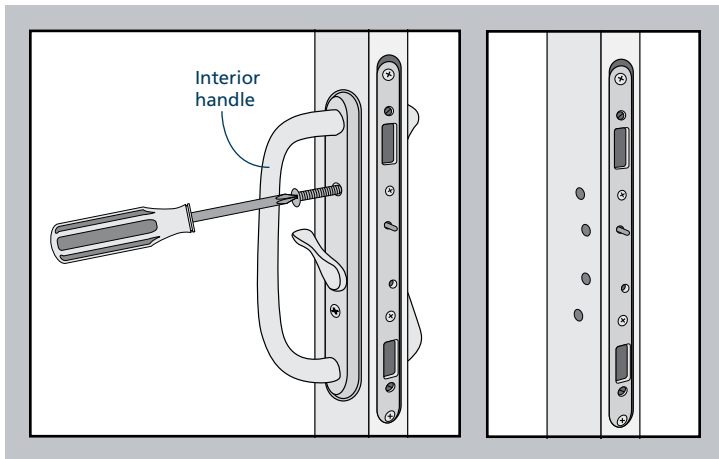

NEEDED TOOLS

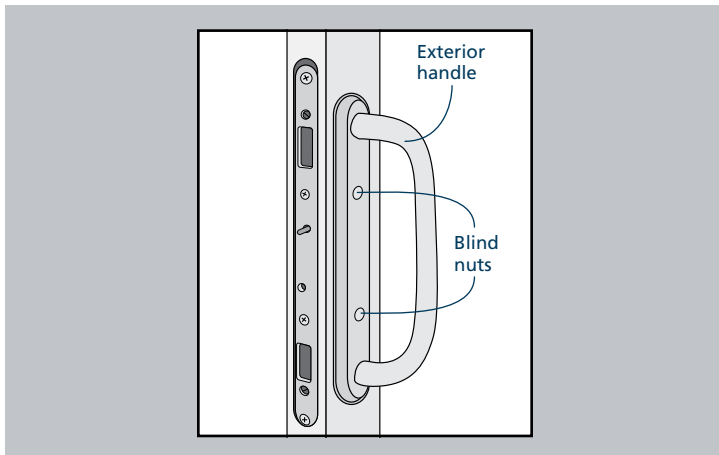
- Phillips head screwdriver

PATIO DOOR INTERIOR HANDLE REPLACEMENT

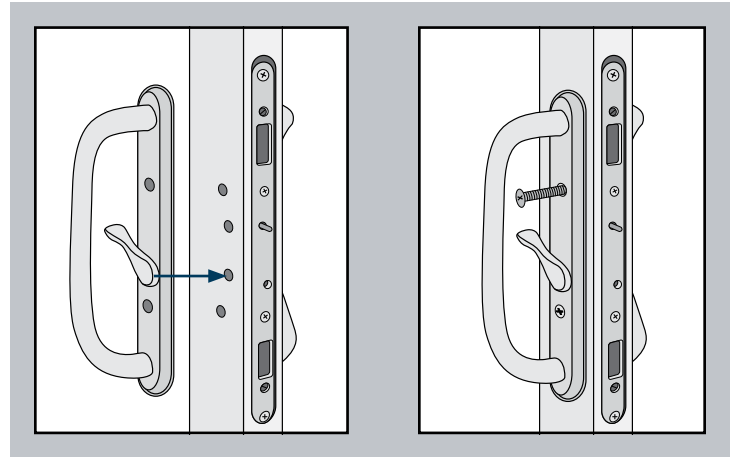
1. Unlock and open the patio door.
2. While holding both handles in place, use the Phillips head screwdriver to remove both screws.
3. Remove both handles.



4. Place the blind nuts of the exterior handle and holes of the interior handle in the alignment holes and hold in place.



5. Install the new screws securing the handles.



6. Close the door and test for proper operation.
