


• Interlock Clip

INTERLOCK CLIP REPLACEMENT


1. Open patio door half way and secure.



2. Insert the putty knife between the panel and the clip. Gently pry to release the clip from the panel from top to bottom.



3. Once the interior side is fully released the entire clip can be removed.



NEEDED TOOLS


• Putty knife

5. Install the new clip by aligning the clip with the top of the panel and seating the exterior side first then firmly pressing the interior to snap into place.



6. Work from the top of the panel to the bottom, seating the exterior side and snap the interior side into place.



7. Check for proper operation.
